GAMES CRIMINALS PLAY

- ◆ The morning session will focus on **Understanding the Problem** while the afternoon session will shift to **Professionalism and Effective Practice**.
- ◆ The participant will have opportunities to clearly understand the subtle and sophisticated games of offenders, specific reasons for the games and specific ways to professionally intervene to minimize risk and improve outcome.
- ◆ Materials will be taken from two reference books, **Games Criminals Play** (Allen and Bosta) and **The Art of the Con** (Cornelius). Training will incorporate group discussion, case examples and video clips. Participants will gain a better understanding of the thinking errors involved in the games that criminals play and the best practices that reduce the risk of recidivism.
