Criminal Tactics in Treatment

- ◆ This session will examine the unique challenges of managing criminal tactics while merging therapeutic and evidence based practices.
- ◆ We will explore specific tactics we may see, our personal characteristics that put us at risk to be manipulated and safeguards to protect against criminal manipulation and tactics.
- ◆ Lastly, we will demonstrate how management of criminal tactics in a group setting will also assist in remaining in line with agency policies and ethical codes.
- ◆ Participants will gain a better understanding of how to use evidence-based practices to effectively respond to criminal tactics in both group and individual settings to change behavior and decrease the likelihood of recidivism.

Currently, her primary duties are managing the Family Programming, Quick Response Team and the Clinical Coordinators who clinically supervisor treatment in a female CBCF facility, male CBCF facility, female halfway house and a community based outpatient treatment facility.
